## Youth Work

At St Francis Church we employ Paul Northam as our Outreach Youth Worker to lead and develop our work with young people in the church and in the wider community. He works with young people aged 11-19, from the last year in primary school and throughout their time at secondary school. He works in partnership with local schools, other local church youth workers and community youth projects, as well as leading our church youth clubs 'Faith' and 'Faithful'.

## We need your help!

After three years the initial start up funding has come to an end and we need to increase our contribution to the costs of this much valued work.

## Invest

You can invest in this work by making a regular donation. Becoming a 'stakeholder' in our youth work is an investment in the young people who are a valuable part of our church and community. It is an investment in a person who helps foster relationships

of trust, who provides support for individuals when they need it and who leads the running of different youth groups in which local young people can participate.

## Lots of small gifts...

This scheme is about sharing the cost of employing a youth worker. It costs £24,000 a year to employ a youth worker. This is a lot of money, but if the cost is shared it becomes achievable. If 400 people contribute £5 a month then the target is reached and this really important work at St Francis can go forward! Each 'stake' in our youth worker costs £5 a month. This is about £1.15 per week – which is less than a cup of tea or coffee in a café, a half-pint of beer, or a medium sized bar of chocolate. If you are a UK taxpayer you can also 'Gift Aid' your donation to make it worth even more.
